The UN Special Rapporteur on the **promotion and protection of human rights in the context of climate change** has issued a second thematic report, on access to information on climate change and Human rights. It is available at <https://www.ohchr.org/en/documents/thematic-reports/a79176-access-information-climate-change-and-human-rights-report-special>

The present report explores the specificities, challenges and good practices related to access to information on climate change and human rights. It clarifies States' international obligations, individually and as part of international cooperation, as well as the responsibility of businesses. The report offers concrete recommendations for States, businesses and the United Nations system to enhance access to information as a prerequisite for the transparency, inclusiveness and effectiveness of decision-making processes on

climate change at all levels. The report will be presented to the UN General Assembly in October. You can also see 90 submissions to the report, which provided invaluable information on:

- Experienced barriers in accessing information on climate change and human rights, and their consequences;

- The specific human rights needs of [children](#) and human rights holders in situations of heightened vulnerability in the context of climate change.
